



LEAVE A GIFT IN YOUR WILL

Please consider leaving a gift for Eye Research in your will. It would support research in Cambridge to develop techniques for eye surgery and treatments for eye diseases.

If you need to make a will, then we recommend that you talk to a professional will writer e.g. a solicitor to ensure your will is legally correct and that your wishes are clear.

If you have a will and would like to add a gift to the Cambridge Eye Trust, your will writer can add your request to your existing will; this is called a Codicil and saves writing a new will.

There are several ways in which to define your gift, being:

- A share of your estate. You may chose to leave whatever is left over after all your other legacies, costs and any taxes have been paid or kept back.
- You may wish to specify a fraction or percentage of your estate or of the residue (balance left).
- A sum of money. Please consider that inflation does not increase the amount unless it is revised regularly or if an automatic annual uplift is specified.
- A specific gift of items such as jewellery, paintings, property and shares.
